Dear Parents,

November was marked by several highly successful Bishop Foley activities. Our 18th Annual Auction at the start of last month will be remembered as one of the best attended events in recent memory. The fall Open House which followed a week later was also one of the busiest ever. We greeted visitors from a variety of schools and parishes. The teachers, students, parents and staff who were present created a welcoming atmosphere. Our guests were shown the balance of academics and extracurricular activities within a Christ-centered environment which distinguishes our school. Evidently, our current parents and students have spread the word about the *Foley Difference*.

The next big event this month is the Cookie Walk on December 3 in the cafeteria from 9:30am-1:00pm. We will be celebrating the Feast of the Immaculate Conception with an all school Mass on Dec. 8. Reconciliation is scheduled for Dec. 12. The choir, under the direction of Mrs. Roberta Roberts, will perform in the annual Christmas Concert on Dec. 13 at 7pm. The next K-12 Mass at Guardian Angels is December 16.

I am reminded of the generosity of the Bishop Foley community through the various collections for the holidays: canned goods for the food pantry and St. Vincent DePaul; toiletries, gently used clothes and coats for Crossroads; and books for underprivileged children. 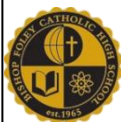

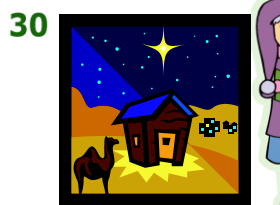
