PRINCIPAL'S LETTER

Dear Parents,

Bishop Foley was well represented at the *Right to Life Rally and March* on Washington DC January 23rd. Mr. McCormick, Mr. Pullis, Ms. Gorial and Mrs. Green accompanied thirty of our students to this annual event. They joined thousands of concerned citizens across the United States to be the voices of those silenced by abortion on the anniversary of Roe vs Wade. They attended a rally at the Verizon Center, Mass at the Basilica, and from the National Mall they marched up Constitution Avenue to the Supreme Court.

Bishop Foley students served as ushers at the Catholic Schools Week Mass for the Archdiocese which was held on Jan. 24 at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral. This year's theme is *Faith, Academics, Service*. We capped off a week (Jan. 29-Feb. 3) filled with special activities and recognition by holding our own CSW celebration on Friday, Feb. 3rd at Guardian Angels at a K-12 Mass. These events remind us that Catholic education is a gift we offer to our children. It allows young people an opportunity to grow and practice faith in God within a value centered curriculum. We thank the dedicated staff and faculty as well as the parents who support our mission. We are proud of the tradition of excellence within a Christ-centered environment. The cost may be expensive; however, the experience is priceless.

We are pleased to announce that tuition for the 2012-13 school year will not be raised from its current level. It remains at \$8,200. However, because of the changes both in volunteer needs and changing class sizes, we have decided to increase the volunteer hours to 14 for the first student and 10 for each additional student. This means that we are asking each family to work one

extra shift per school year. The fee for an un-worked service hour will remain at \$40 per hour. We are also asking that the parents of athletes participate in the annual spring/fall clean ups. At this point, it is a request not a mandate. Yet in the spirit of the Foley Family we would hope that all athletic groups' help with this clean up.

For those interested in applying for grants for next year or for those who already receive grants but still need to submit PSAS forms each year, be sure to check the web page for the new 2012-2013 forms. PSAS forms are mailed directly to Cleveland, Ohio. The deadline is April 1st. Only one PSAS form needs to be submitted when applying for Bishop Foley grants as well as the Stewards for Tomorrow grants from the Archdiocese of Detroit.

Mrs. Chabot will visit individual classrooms to discuss course selections for next year during the week of Feb. 20-24. The entire course catalog is available on line along with all the necessary forms for registration. Check the website. www.bishopfoley.org The next Open House is on Sunday, Feb. 12 from 1-3pm. We're counting on our current students to spread the word about Bishop Foley Catholic and invite students who are looking for an outstanding high school.

Keep in mind that Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held on Thursday, Feb. 23 from 5-8pm. The next day, Feb. 24, is a full day of classes. However, the winter break begins at dismissal that Friday. All students and staff return to school on March 5.
