### Vision Screening for Ninth Graders

Students entering high school face many educational challenges as they prepare for responsible adulthood. At least 80% of learning is mediated through vision. Impaired vision is one of the most common health problems affecting children. By high school graduation one third will have a vision problem requiring correction.

To assure that ninth graders have adequate vision to meet educational demands, Michigan Public Health Code, act 368, recommends vision screening for ninth graders. To meet the screening needs of these students, the Oakland County Health Division offers free vision screening by appointment at the North Oakland Health Center and South Oakland Health Center locations. Parents can call (248) 424-7070 to schedule an appointment.

BFC parents are encouraged to look into vision screening for their ninth grader. Additional information is available Dianne Ferber, Vision and Hearing Program Director for the Oakland County Health Division. She can be reached at 248-424-7071.

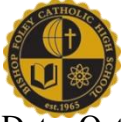

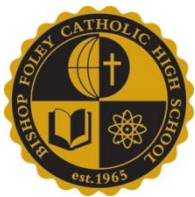

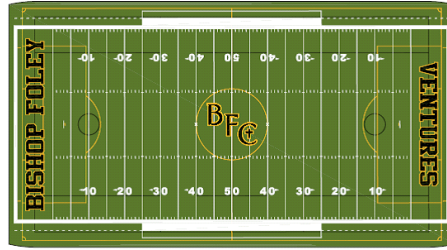

## Please take time to read this **IMPORTANT Letter about the Track and Turf Project**

Over the past several months you may have been hearing a lot about the efforts to build a synthetic turf athletic field and track here at Bishop Foley. **It is with great enthusiasm and pride that the committee of parents, alumni, and friends of Foley can say that on September 2<sup>nd</sup>, Bishop Foley will christen the new field.**

With your generosity and support we have been able to raise over \$350,000 towards the installation of the field. Although this is an incredible amount of money, we still need your help!

In order to begin the field this summer, additional funds were required. In early May, the BFC Administration was approached by a group of investors who believe in this project and wanted to help make this dream a **Reality**. Money was advanced from these investors with the understanding that the Turf Committee would continue to fund raise to cover these advanced funds. This offer allows current families/donors the ability to fully benefit from this venture this year. We want to make it clear that none of the money needed for the turf field or track is coming from Bishop Foley Catholic High School.

This is our chance to show the community that Bishop Foley is alive and well! It is our hope and prayer that this "Field of Dreams" project will not only **help draw kids to our school** but also through field and track rentals **generate funds**. Funds which will help provide much needed building updates as well as additional Foley scholarships. The Turf Committee is fully aware that Bishop Foley Catholic is in need of improvements within the school. The turf project provides a \$20,000 savings to the school each year by eliminating the cost of field maintenance. This savings along with revenue gained from rentals will provide substantial income for the school to help with our needed updates.

With the field installation underway and scheduled to be completed by September 2nd, our goal is to generate enough money to complete the track. We are about \$20,000 short of having enough money to begin this project. We know that many of you feel the same way we do about Bishop Foley and want good things for the school and our children. **Imagine if just 250 of the families and alumni of Bishop Foley donated \$100 each, Foley would be able to install a new track.**

Foley is like a book:

The fields and track are its cover which draws the reader/students in.

The teachers, classes, and opportunities are its pages that unfold as students live out their 4 high school years.

Please help us add a new chapter to the book, by donating to the future of Foley.

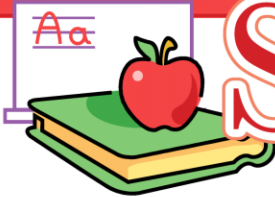
