Each year many students undergo surgeries or sustain injuries that prohibit them from going up two flights of stairs to the second level for classes. For several weeks these students remain in the media center during class periods and miss out on valuable in class interactions. If a student is wheelchair bound this problem becomes more of a learning barrier. Please help us to do God's work and welcome all students to learn and grow within the walls of Bishop Foley Catholic. Our goal is to raise enough funds to install an elevator within the year.

### **AMY UEBBING**

(FEB. 28, 1963 - AUG. 5, 2019)

Amy Uebbing, former VP for Advancement, was a bright light here at Bishop Foley Catholic who will be greatly missed. She was the heart of the Advancement Department, and worked tirelessly to bring the schools mission to life on a daily basis. Amy always went above and beyond, doing whatever was needed and then some, and whatever would help Bishop Foley the most. She was truly one of a kind, and the memories of her sense of humor, passion, and loving heart will always be cherished.



Going the extra mile in one of her upper level courses landed alumna Carly Finegan ('15) with an invitation for an adventure of a lifetime! Carly's dedication and interest in doing research in Environmental Geosciences was rewarded by one of her teaching assistants with an offer to join a field work trip to Alaska. While in Alaska, Carly completed field work for a National Science Foundation funded project called CALM (Circumpolar Active Layer Monitoring program). CALM was established in 1991 with the goal to monitor the thickness of the active layer, soil temperature, air temperature and vertical movement in sites around the Arctic and Antarctic circles. Carly worked with an international field team to collect information at various sites. "While there, I traveled by helicopter, 9 passenger plane, 5 passenger plane, truck, and foot. I drove the entire transect of Alaska, from Anchorage to Fairbanks, Fairbanks to Toolik, and then Toolik to Deadhorse."



Aside from all of the work being done, she was able to see some beautiful landscapes and animals. "The drives from Anchorage to Fairbanks and Fairbanks to Toolik were two of the most beautiful drives I have ever done in my life. From the mountains and the valleys to the abundant meandering rivers, it is easy to see how beautifully God created the world in Alaska." One of the most memorable parts of her trip was during a helicopter ride between remote sites where she was able to see a large moose. "It amazes me how such large animals, like moose, muskox, caribou, and bears, can thrive in the tundra and it was a joy every time I saw wildlife while doing field work.", says Finegan.

Carly credits Bishop Foley with instilling values in her that have helped her thrive in her undergraduate coursework, internships and relationship with God.

"Bishop Foley's roots and foundation in the Catholic faith has taught me to turn to God no matter what. In good times and bad, I find myself turning my heart to God to thank Him for the opportunities, friendships, and experiences He has given me or to ask Him for his help." Carly is currently attending Saint Louis University to obtain her Master's in Environmental Giosciences.

# **CAMPUS MINISTRY**



Catholic Athletes for Christ finished up its 3rd year with over 60 student-athletes in the club.




The softball team was also named district champions in the spring.

Our FIRST Robotics Team, The Foley Freeze, had another successful season in 2019. At competition, they were District finalists at Troy and District Winners at Forest Hills, where they were featured on ESPN's coverage of the event. In addition to success on the field, they also received an award at each competition they attended, and were voted by other teams to be in the Top 10 robots competing at the World Championship. They were recognized with the Engineering Inspiration, Autonomous, and Industrial Design Awards at the District level. At both the MI State Championship & World Championship, they were again awarded for their outstanding robot automation with the Autonomous Award. Our robotics program continues to prepare students to succeed in future education and careers in STEM. From the class of 2019, Andrew Dixon & Gavin Jendza received the competitive FIRST scholarship to Kettering

University. The FIRST Robotics Competition continues to grow in the state of Michigan, with the number of FIRST Robotics teams eclipsing the number of varsity football teams in the 2018-2019 school year. The Foley Freeze is currently busy preparing for the



### **ALL IN THE FOLEY FAMILY**

Kelly Scaccia is a 1992 Foley grad who is Secretary of the Alumni Board, and married to alumnus David Scaccia ('91). They have three daughters, recent grad Isabella ('19), current student Priscilla ('21) and future Venture Lucia. We caught up with Kelly to discuss how she keeps it all in the Foley Family.

#### YOU GRADUATED IN 1991. WHAT WAS BFC LIKE BACK THEN?

Foley in the late 80s, early 90s was pretty different from today. Although Theology was everyday, every year, mass was occasional. The chapel was too small for mass so the gym was used in its place. The chapel was the 'go to' place when you had to 'chat' things out with a friend. Uniforms didn't exist, but the dress code was strict and we had Mrs. Russell in the hall looking over us in between classes to make sure we were in code. Lockers were used in between all classes, not the backpacks today. We had so many beloved teachers during that time and I hope they know how pivotal they were and how vividly they are remembered when alumni talk about their days at Foley.

#### WHAT WERE SOME OF YOUR FAVORITE EXPERIENCES AS A STUDENT?

Some of my favorite experiences as a student at BFC were the annual Foley Fest in February, typing class (which has been with me throughout my life and is an asset), winning our Powderpuff games both Junior and Senior year, football games in the stands with friends, Homecoming in the cafeteria/pit (freshman couldn't go, just like today), proms, the friends I have made for life even if we don't talk often and my husband who stole my heart freshman year. Foley family is a real thing, not a motto.



### WHAT MADE YOU DECIDE TO SEND YOUR CHILDREN TO BFC? HOW HAS IT BEEN GETTING TO SEE THEM AS STUDENTS IN THE SAME HIGH SCHOOL YOU WENT TO?

When our oldest wanted to continue with her Catholic education, we gave her a budget list of schools that were optional and her last choice was Foley. She wasn't interested in the distance and thought we were going to pressure her as Foley alumni, so she saved it for last to shadow (VIP visit). She declared at pickup she loved it and that was the school she wanted to go to. Out of all the schools she shadowed, she said the students were the most friendly, the staff of teachers were down-to-earth and the distance would be worth it. Watching them attend Foley has been pretty cool, but a little weird, too. They are more spirited than we ever were and have embraced the stronger Catholicism practices Foley now practices. Watching them wear uniforms is new to us, but we love the elimination of chaos we experienced because of it. In the end, watching them wear black and gold and the Foley logo (I know it's BFC today, but to us, it is and always will be Foley)has resurrected our spirit as dedicated Foley alumni.

#### HOW HAS YOUR EXPERIENCE BEEN AS A CURRENT PARENT? WHAT ARE THINGS YOU LOVE ABOUT BFC?

My experience as a current Foley parent has been a good one. We have trusted the staff with our children and watching our kids grow into young, dependable adults is in part due to their daily surroundings at Foley. I love the history of the school such as the Venture in the gym, the original tile in the halls, the beloved chocolate chip cookies still on the menu, the class composites for browsing that haven't moved an inch in all these years, and the beautiful staple of the cafeteria that continues to house so many memories for current students, while holding so many old for the alumni. When I walk in through the same entrance used today taking me into that cafeteria, I have a moment each time that takes me back to some of the best days of my life. It's an honor and blessing to share the same alma mater as my kids.
