GRADING POLICY

Grades will be calculated on a weighted scale. Students will be assessed on the following:

- Homework/Classwork - 30% of total grade
- Quizzes - 20% of total grade (1-2 per unit)
- Test - 50% of total grade (1 test per unit)



HOMEWORK/LATE WORK POLICY

All classes have online platforms from the given textbook where students complete homework online and get automatic feedback. The platform for Algebra 2 is BigIdeasMath, Pre-Calculus utilizes Webassign, and Statistics uses MyMathLab (Pearson). If a student is absent and wants a copy of filled-in notes, they must email me by 3PM on the day they are absent. Students are usually given homework assignments daily at the end of each class. Students typically have time to begin working on the class assignment, but homework assignments will be mainly completed at home. Homework is due the following day before class starts.

Students can receive late credits/points on homework assignments up to one week after the original due date. Students will lose a day's worth of credit for every day that the assignment is late. After the deadline, the student cannot make up the assignment and will receive a zero in the gradebook.



HOW CAN A STUDENT SUCCEED IN YOUR CLASS?

I put my weekly lesson plans on Google Classroom under "Weekly Agenda." Students can access a blank copy of the notes for that day as well as see the homework that has been assigned. If absent, students need to email me directly and are encouraged to check the agenda weekly and stay on top of their work.
