GRADING POLICY

Grades will be calculated on a weighted scale. Students will be assessed on the following:

- Homework/Classwork - 20% of total grade
- Quizzes - 30% of total grade (1-2 per unit)
- Test – 50% of total grade (1 test per unit)

HOMEWORK/LATE WORK POLICY

All classes have online platforms from the given textbook where students complete homework online and get automatic feedback. Algebra 2 homework can be accessed on BigIdeasMath and Statistics homework can be accessed on MyMathLab. If the student is absent, they will get an email with a copy of the notes that we completed in class (has the filled in responses and examples) and the homework that was assigned. Students are usually given homework assignments daily at the end of each class. Students usually have time to begin working on the assignment in class, but mainly homework assignments will be completed at home.

Students can receive late credits/points on homework assignments up to one full week after the original due date. Students will lose a day's worth of credit for every day that the assignment is late. After the deadline has passed, the student will be unable to make up the assignment and will receive a zero in the gradebook.
