GRADING POLICY

My grading is not weighted. Each assignment is given the appropriate amount of points and deductions are taken for late assignments.



HOMEWORK/LATE WORK POLICY

Assignments are placed on Google classroom. All assignments are given with ample time to complete during the classes. Occasionally homework is given but it is not often, most work will be done in class with the exception of studying for quizzes.

If a student is absent for any reason, they are responsible for getting the notes and finding out what they missed. I follow what is stated in the handbook for turning in work after an absence. As stated above, there are deductions taken for late work. It is their responsibility to contact me through email prior to the end of class before or on the day of the class they are missing.
