GRADING POLICY

Grades are weighted. There is one project per quarter, along with a daily planner check. Planners are to be completed PRIOR to the start of class, from the previous day. Freshmen Transition students MAY have additional homework as determined by class need.



HOMEWORK/LATE WORK POLICY

Seminar students are expected to bring their completed planner to class each day. Freshmen Transition students also need to bring their completed planner to class. Freshmen have a quarterly project: Vision Board and Postsecondary Learning. Finally, lessons promoting academic success will be interspersed throughout the semester, so there may be occasional homework.

Due to the nature of this class, no late homework is accepted. IF a student is absent, they should return to school with their planner completed for the day(s) they missed. This will help them to "catch up" on any missing work/assessments from their absence.
