GRADING POLICY

All of my classes use a total points system. Each point matters. Homework, daily writing, smaller quizzes range from ~1-25 points . Projects, tests, and papers range from ~20-60 points. Homework and classwork grades are entered before the end of the quarter. Missing assignments, even small ones, will be detrimental to an overall grade in this system. *Elective grading (Publications, Creative Writing) may vary.

HOMEWORK/LATE WORK POLICY

Late work is taken on a case-by-case and student-by-student basis. Students should communicate absences or the need for extended time responsibly and ahead of time to be given consideration. Homework varies from night to night, but it can always be found under Classwork on Google Classroom. Students should also be keeping an agenda themselves; the itinerary for the day will be on the overhead and discussed at the beginning of class. Missing assignments will become 0's by end of card marking.
