# 2017 Distinguished Alum: Frank Demers, '91



The annual Distinguished Alumni Award was presented for the first time at the Homecoming celebration on September 29.

## **Russ Ortisi '83**

As a student at Foley, Russ Ortisi noticed how the Catholic faith was prevalent everywhere at the school, not just in the religion classes. "I still greatly cherish my time at Bishop Foley. In addition to the great preparation for college and entering into a career, the importance of integrating our Catholic faith into all aspects of our education, and frankly into all of who we are as persons, has had a significant impact on the person I am today," states Ortisi.

He also credits the teachers, past and present, for the impact they had, saying, "The passion that the teachers have is another thing that stands out. Their service at Foley is not just about a job, but about a mission that each one has accepted – that of forming those young people, who are fortunate enough to attend the school, into the best human beings they can be!"

After graduating from Foley, Ortisi attended Oakland University and earned a Bachelor of Science in accounting. He always admired his father, who was an accountant, and decided to follow his same career path. Ortisi then went on to earn his MBA with a concentration in International Business. His love for technology took him on the path to working as a Business Analyst. This led to other opportunities at AT&T Systems Leasing, Heller Financial and General Electric and increasing levels of responsibility. Currently he is the Vice President of Information Technology at Automotive Industry Action Group (AIAG), a not-for-profit trade association that supports the auto industry.

In 2011, he responded to a calling that he felt God was guiding him towards. Ortisi began pursuing a Master of Arts in Pastoral Studies at Sacred Heart Major Seminary. For many years he felt God was calling him to serve in the church in a special way. He embarked on the journey towards becoming a permanent Deacon, and will be ordained on October 21.

## Natalia Petraszczuk '96

As a Foley Venture, Natalia Petraszczuk was heavily involved with extra-curricular activities. She was involved with the debate team, served as senior class President and was the captain on both the track and volleyball teams. She credits Foley for helping her establish her first leadership roles and learning how to think quickly articulate her thoughts.



After graduating from BFC, Petraszczuk studied International Relations at Michigan State University and graduated from the honors program in 2000. She started her professional career as the Development Director of the Michigan Environmental Council and then moved to EarthShare, a nation-wide nonprofit. At EarthShare, she rose to the position of Managing Director.

In 2014, she entered a business startup competition that would change her life and trajectory of her career path towards entrepreneurship. She received validation for her Vizbe concept, an online corporate goal-setting and work/life balance tool, and beat 2,500 international teams to win the Google sponsored Global Start Up Battle. Vizbe has now launched with four corporate clients, and has raised over \$300,000 in angel investment and prize money.

Besides being an accomplished entrepreneur, Petraszczuk has many achievements, including being honored as EarthShare's "Sales Employee of the Year" in 2013, attended the Inforum inGage Entrepreneurial & Business Training program in 2015, and completed the elite American Express Leadership Academy. In addition to being an entrepreneur, Natalia is also a certified life coach, motivational speaker, and on-air talent for media.
